She was a Bunco member with the same wonderful group of friends, for over 50 years. Barbara was an amazing cook and she loved to plan meals and share with her beloved family and friends. famous deviled eggs. She cooked for her daughter and son-in-law, daily, with love, including the day before she passed. She was a talented crafter and her projects and hobbies, over the years, included Ceramics, Miniature's (many barns and a general store), Scrapbooking and over the last 3 years, she made over 80 Diamond Paintings... many that she shared with family and friends.
