



Bernard Stammmis

April 11, 1936 - August 29, 2022

Bernard A. Stammmis, 86, of Crown Point, passed away peacefully at his home on August 29, 2022. He was preceded in death by parents John and Christina (nee Recker); by sister Geraldine (Sjoerdsma); and by brothers Martin, John, Arnold and Cornelius "George".

Bernie is survived by his wife of 55 years, Betty (nee Pater); by sister Janet (O'Connell); by brothers Tom and Bill; by his children John, Brent and Mary Beth; by 10 grandchildren, and 2 great-grandchildren.

Born in 1936, Bernie grew up on a farm in Griffith, and saw many changes during his 80+ years living in Northwest Indiana. One of his memories included walking the family's horses from a field in Highland back to Griffith along 45th Street after a day of working in the fields. He graduated from Griffith High School and continued through different jobs until he settled into his postal career spanning 30 years. During that time, he delivered thousands of letters, often taking a few minutes to chit chat with those on his route who looked forward to his reliable delivery. Bernie was deeply embedded in the small town he spent most of his life in, and he always greeted everyone with a genuine smile. He ended his career at the US Postal Service in 1996, retiring after 30 years.

Some of the fondest memories throughout Bernie's life involved visiting the

various Indiana State Parks with his family in tow. Hours were spent hiking, swimming, and exploring the outdoors together.

Bernie loved seeing his family, selling antiques, and growing tomatoes in the church garden right through this last season of his life. He also loved to talk about cars, and his attention to weather forecasts was particularly exceptional.

The love and attention that Bernie and Betty showed to each other, especially as they aged, was an inspiration and example to all those who knew them. He is now home with Jesus.
