



Bonnie Brock

April 11, 1956 - September 20, 2022

Bonnie Jean Brock was born in Knoxville, Tennessee, on April 11, 1956, to Eugene and Dixie Gibson. Growing up she loved swimming and animals; she even had a pony as a child. At the age of 9, Bonnie accepted Christ as her Saviour.

She attended Westwood for Jr High and Manchester Central for high school. While in high school, she worked at Kentucky Fried Chicken where she met her high school sweetheart and future husband, Reed.

Reed and Bonnie were married on July 3, 1975, in Manchester, Tennessee.

Later Reed and Bonnie were visited by his nephew to come visit a Baptist church. After visiting for several weeks Reed got saved due to the continual influence and prayers of Bonnie.

Reed and Bonnie prayed for children for 16 years. On November 10, 1991, they were blessed with triplets, David, Jonathan, and Kimberly. The triplets were born 14 weeks early and due to these circumstances each one was left with health problems. David and Kimberly both have several physical complications, and Jonathan passed away at six months of age, never getting to come home from the hospital.

They moved to Northwest Indiana to attend First Baptist Church and College. Bonnie was faithful in the Phoster Club ministry where she was named soul-winner of the year on several occasions. Bonnie loved to win souls. She would often take David and Kimberly with her, teaching them to win souls, and using their story to lead people to Christ.

In 2006, Bonnie had a massive stroke. She was in a coma for over a month, and Reed was told she would never walk, talk, or respond in any way ever again. Through perseverance, faith, and hard work, within 1 year Bonnie, though in a wheelchair, was back with her family playing games, traveling, and riding every roller coaster she could ride!

Bonnie loved life. She loved playing games, traveling, bowling, eating out, and CHOCOLATE. But most of all she loved her family. Her husband and her children were Bonnie's whole life. She wanted to be nothing more in life than what she was, a homemaker and stay at home mommy. Through her hard work, she taught David and Kimberly to walk, talk, and to live their life as independently as they possibly could.

Bonnie lived her life for the Lord with strength and grace. On September 20, 2022, Bonnie went to be with her Saviour. She is survived by her husband, Reed Brock; her children, David Brock and Kimberly Brock; her mother, Dixie Gibson; her brother Wayne (Tammy) Gibson; and two nephews and one niece.

She was preceded in death by her father, Eugene Gibson, and her son, Jonathan Brock.

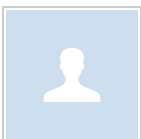
