



## Carl "Victor" Litherland

C. Victor Litherland passed away on Sunday, November 14, 2021. He was a lifelong resident of Northwest Indiana, but deeply connected to his Southern Illinois roots.

Victor is preceded in death by his beloved wife of over 50 years, Priscilla Timperley Litherland; son David Litherland; and sister Beverly Litherland.
