Daniel Hidalgo, age 70, of Crown Point, Indiana, passed away on Friday, October 5, 2018. He is survived by his loving wife, Brenda; his loving children: Daniel (Laura) Roman Hidalgo, and Nick (Maritza) Hidalgo; and his beloved grandchildren: Jaiden, Joseph, Ava, Ariana, and Nico. He was preceded in death by his father, Brigido; his brother, Raymond; and his sisters: Sandra and Dedra.
