



## Glenda "Sue" Brown

April 8, 1946 - June 17, 2026

Glenda Sue (Montgomery) Brown of Whiting, IN, passed away peacefully on June 17, 2026, at Methodist Hospital in Merrillville, Indiana. She was 80 years old. Glenda was born on April 8, 1946, in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, to Floyd Montgomery of Malvern, Arkansas, and Azzlee (Fields) Montgomery of Vanduser, Missouri.
