James L. Williams, also known as Jim, Dad and Pappaw, of Highland, IN, formerly of Wheelersburg, OH, Fostoria, OH, Findlay, OH, and Merrillville, IN passed away in the early morning hours on Friday, March 29, 2024. Many people remarked about the beautiful sunrise and the beautiful clouds as Jim traded his earthly life for his eternal home.
