July 7, 1959 - August 1, 2020

On Saturday, August 1, 2020, Marion Lela Davenport, age 61, of Merrillville, Indiana, transitioned peacefully to Heaven. After growing up in Pontiac, Michigan, Marion attended and graduated from Hyles-Anderson College in Crown Point, Indiana, where she was employed in the admissions office for many years.
