Minerva “Ann” Kincaid, 84, of Hammond, Indiana, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, August 9, 2020. 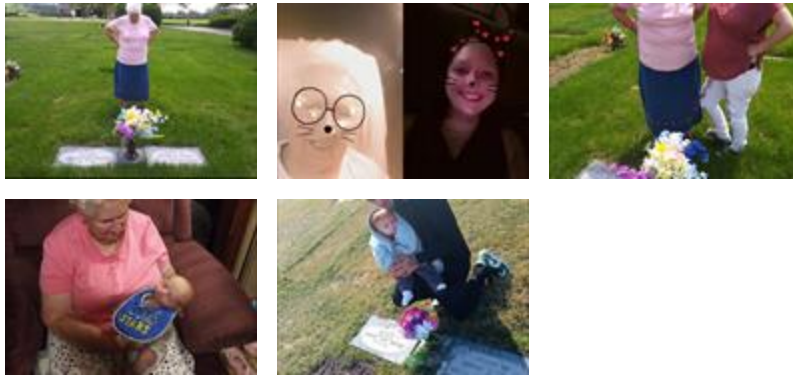

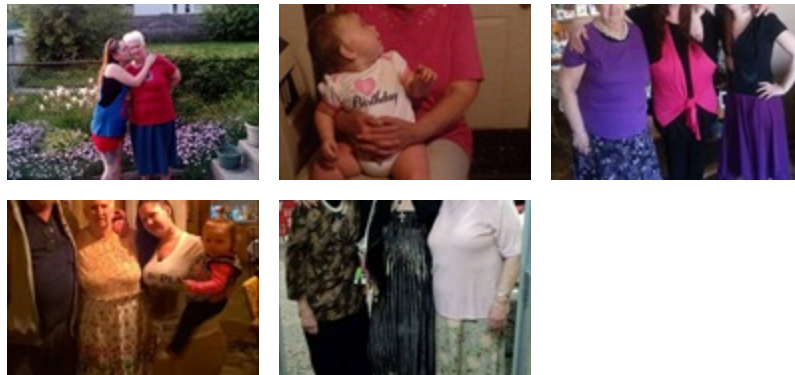
