Paul Stuart Collins, sixty-six years old, went to be with his Lord at 4:55 AM on March 19, 2021. He was surrounded by his family when he passed suddenly from an aneurysm.

He resided in Hammond, Indiana for the past fourteen years, where he served faithfully at the First Baptist Church of Hammond as the building Manager and host of the Power Club radio show on 90.5 "The Key".
