March 13, 1928 - June 11, 2024

Richard Joseph Wilson, a devoted family man, person of deep faith, and proud veteran, passed away peacefully on June 11, 2024 in Merrillville, Indiana at the age of 96.

Born on March 13, 1928 in Hammond, Indiana to Frank and Helen Wilson, Richard grew up to embody the values of hard work, integrity, and commitment to community.
